Substances in articles

Increased import



- Chemical content unknown
- Concern about unwanted substances:
 - carcinogenic, mutagenic, toxic to reproduction
 - persistent, bioaccumulative, toxic
 - endocrine disruptive
- Negative impact on health and environment



What is an article?

• Chemical product: "classic" chemicals such as paint, glue, solvents, detergents.



 Pesticides: biocides and plant protection products. For example wood preservatives, repellants, agrochemicals.



 Article: "means an object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design which determines its function to a greater degree than does its chemical composition.

Consideration rules of the Swedish Environmental Code (1998:808, chapter 2)

The knowledge principle; The one conducting an activity is to have the sufficient knowledge to manage the risks it gives rise to.

The precautionary principle; You are to undertake the risk management actions that this knowledge requires

The substitution principle; You are to avoid dangerous products (and techniques) if there are significantly less dangerous substitutes available.





1. XRF




2. Sent to an external accredited laboratory




 If the article contain exceeded levels of a restricted substance the company is reported to the prosecutors office




The result of enforcement activities in Sweden 2008-2013




